AUTHORIZATION TO CONTACT OTHER SIGNIFICANT CAREGIVER (Rev. 1.0)

The Canadian Co-Parenting Centres believe that when working with children it is usually beneficial to have all significant caregivers involved to some degree. Also, pursuant to Canada's Divorce Act, even if one parent has sole custody, the 'access parent' is entitled to information.

16. (5) Unless the court orders otherwise, a spouse who is granted access to a child of the marriage has the right to make inquiries, and to be given information, as to the health, education and welfare of the child.
